### **Board Meeting**

**Tuesday, March 9, 2010**

**Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 7:05pm by Karen Bledsoe. A quorum was established.

**Minutes:** Georgia Wheeler made a motion to accept the minutes as amended. Lisa Monig seconded the motion. The minutes were approved.

**Treasurer's Report:** Steve Downes made a motion to accept the budget report. Lisa Monig seconded the motion. The budget report was approved.

### **Director's Reports:**

Griffin: No report (open house at Griffin)

Lakeview: No report (open house at Lakeview)

- TCHS: Mr. Flisowski thanked everyone who helped with the Pre-UIL event. He suggested that next time we have families pre-pay for the spaghetti dinner. Also, next year the band boosters will be in charge of the meal to decide the meal-type to be offered (Spaghetti vs. Hot Dogs). It was also discussed that Lakeview provided 10 people as promised for cleanup and setup, and they had roughly the amount of kids to eat that Mr. Anderson had predicted, so they will not be charged for the money lost in this endeavor. It was emphasized that this was a learning experience for next year.
- At the orchestra contest today (3/9) both orchestra's made Division I scores.
- There will be a Pre-UIL event tomorrow evening (3/10) at Hebron.
- Due to the state basketball finals, school will be let out at 1:00pm on Thursday 3/11
- There will be another Pre-UIL event on April 8 at TCHS. (One week before UIL)
- UIL dates are April 14 and 15.
- April 16 Symphonic and Wind symphony will attend a festival at the Myerson Center at 7:30 and 8:00am. Concert Band will be at Wakeland that day.
- The school board voted on 3/8 for a new school start time of 8:15am. School will let out at 3:30. Band practice will begin at 4pm on Mondays. Tuesday-Friday practice will be at 6:45am.

### **Committee Reports:**

- Chuckwagon: Mike Monig has had a change in his work schedule and will not be able to do Chuckwagon next year. His position must be filled.
- Colorguard: Winterguard updates:  
There is a competition this Friday 3/12.

The championships will be March 27 in Grand Prairie.  
Out of 12 teams, we were 7<sup>th</sup> in the last competition Feb. 27 in Aledo.

Lisa suggested a cookie dough fundraiser for the color guard.

- Fundraising: fundraising updates:
  - Spring Bulbs: There were 11 orders for bulbs for a total of about \$600, of which we will receive ½.
  - Dr Pepper Centre: We worked 9 concession stand nights during Cirque de Soleil. We were complemented on our handling of the stands. Our concession stand made more than the other concession stands. We made 12% of the sales for a total of \$1471.00. They would like to ask us back for future events.
  - Frisco Rough Rider fundraiser: The fundraiser includes selling tickets to a RoughRider game at markup. The tickets sell for \$16 but we will sell them for \$20.00. They will allow the TCHS band to play the National Anthem if we commit to 500 tickets. Lisa made a motion to commit to selling 250 tickets to the May 29 game. Sandra seconded the motion. The motion carried.
  - Pizza Hut Park: Dianna Perry is going to training on 3/10. More information to follow her training.
  - Golf Tournament: Steve Downes is coordinating the golf tournament. Discussion involved having a small tournament to get experience in having these types of events. Friday, May 7 at Stewart's Creek. \$50 for those who sign up through April 15, and \$75 after that. Price includes food afterward and a cart. Steve will do a website link similar to the Spring Bulb link. The tournament will be held as a scramble format. Every player will get a certificate to come back and play again free (green fee only.) Mr. Flisowski suggested that we send out a Flashpoint email. Steve will contact businesses for sponsorships- \$100 for a banner, \$200 for a hole sponsorship.
