Spectator Information

Accessibility: Mustang Panther Stadium is fully accessible for guests with special needs on the home and visitor side. General admission and reserved seats offer wheelchair space and companion seating. Ramps and an elevator lead to both general and reserved seats. Handicap parking is also available, but is limited.

Clear Bag Policy: GCISD has implemented a Clear Bag Policy at Mustang Panther Stadium. Fans are encouraged to limit the number of items they bring with them to the stadium. They will be permitted to carry one (1) of the following style and size bags into the stadium:

- Bags that are clear plastic, vinyl, or PVC and do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"
- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag (Ziploc bag or similar)
- An exception will be made for medically necessary items and diaper bags after proper inspection
- Prohibited bags include but are not limited to: purses larger than a clutch bag, coolers, briefcases, backpacks, fanny packs, cinch bags, luggage, seat cushions, computer bags, camera bags, binocular cases, or any bag larger than the permissible size

Ticketing Information: We encourage purchasing tickets online before arriving at the stadium to expedite entry into the stadium.

- Tickets may be purchased in advance at hometownticketing.com
- Tickets are subject to availability and dependent on capacity limits.

Fan Information:

- Stadium gates open one hour prior to kickoff.
- Once fans enter the stadium, they will not be allowed to exit and reenter the stadium without purchasing an additional ticket.
- Mechanical noisemakers (such as whistles or airhorns), skateboards, scooters, balls, and powder are prohibited.
- All signs or banners must comply with University Interscholastic League guidelines. GCISD administration reserves the right to remove or confiscate signs that are in violation of these guidelines.
- All tobacco (including electronic smoking devices), alcohol, and firearms are prohibited
- No outside food or drinks
- Service animals only allowed



Visitor Team and Extracurricular Information

All visitor buses will park in the bus lanes directly behind the visitor stands.

Football equipment may be unloaded at the north gate, but the truck and trailer must be in visitor parking prior to the stadium opening/ambulance arrival.

Band equipment may unload at the south end zone behind the scoreboard. Band trailers will remain parked at the south gate, parallel with Mustang Drive throughout the duration of the football game.

The visiting football team will enter the locker room area from the northeast end of the stadium.

Visiting band, dance and cheerleaders will enter the stadium on the northeast corner of the stadium and walk up the hill to their designated section. Cheerleaders will enter the track area from the steps at the bottom of the visiting stands.

Event staff will be on hand to help direct students and sponsors to their designated location.

People entering through the north and south field gates (cheer, band, dance, etc...) will not be held to the Clear Bag Policy.

Anyone entering through the ticket gates must adhere to the clear bag procedures.





MUSTANG PANTHER STADIUM COLLEYVILLE Clear Bag Procedures


For the safety and security of all attendees, clear bag procedures will be enforced for all GCISD varsity football games at Mustang-Panther Stadium (MPS). Approved and non-approved bags are shown below.

APPROVED BAGS

Attendees will be permitted to carry one (1) of the following style and size bags into the stadium:

CLEAR BAGS

Bags that are clear plastic, vinyl, or PVC and do not exceed 12"x 6"x 12"



CLEAR RESEALABLE PLASTIC STORAGE BAGS

One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag (Ziploc bag or similar)



SMALL BAGS

The only non-clear bags permitted are small bags (with or without a strap) no larger than the size of a hand.



Exceptions to the clear bag protocol will be made for credentialed media and those with necessary items after proper inspection.

Student participants including trainers, cheerleaders, dance teams, and the band will be able to continue to use their team-issued bags but must enter through the media/field entrances.

Grapevine High School and Colleyville Heritage High School booster clubs will have branded clear bags available for purchase.

PROHIBITED BAGS

Prohibited bags include but are



*Seat cushions with areas where items can be concealed are not permitted. Seat cushions without storage areas are permitted.

Any bag larger than the permissible size

Binocular bags

Media, Press Box and Film Deck

The press box and film deck may be accessed by stairs or an elevator near the main gate of the stadium.

- The deadline to fill out the press box, field and all-access credentials, is every Wednesday on game weeks.
- Credentials will be issued at the Media/VIP Gate attached to the concessions building by the north end of the stadium up the media pass gate ramp.
